

University of Wyoming Wall Street Journal Access

University of Wyoming students, faculty, and staff may set up an individual account to *The Wall Street Journal (WSJ)* through the UW subscription. Access to the subscription ends when a student leaves or graduates UW, or when faculty and staff leave university employment.

On the first webpage, your UW information "should" autopopulate in the account fields IF you are signed into any sort of UW account such as Outlook, Office, or Sharepoint. If not, enter your name and UW email address.

Select the appropriate account type – Student, Faculty, or Staff.


Enter the password you want to use for this site.

If you do not want to receive offers from the *WSJ*, deselect the checkbox.

Click in the box to acknowledge the terms of service (Privacy Notice, Subscriber Agreement, Cookie Notice).

Click the blue "Create" button.
